Let us create a memorable wedding day for you and your guests. Perfect for laid-back couples that want to leave the frills and stress behind and embrace a simple event filled with love and laughter.

BOOKING PROCESS

Contact group sales to check date availability. We will provide a contract and require a \$500 deposit to hold your date. The deposit will be applied to the final bill and balance will be due three weeks prior to the event. All payments are final.

FAIRE ACCESS

Weddings will be held from 12:00pm-2:00pm or 4:00pm-6:00pm. You may arrive no earlier than one hour prior to your event time to set up decorations and clear the area no later than one hour after your event.

The Castle Gates open to the public at 11:00am. This is the earliest the Wedding Party may enter the grounds.

WEDDING CEREMONY

Couples must provide their own officiant.* There is no altar provided, nor any other semblance of church; please advise your Clergy.

DECORATIONS

No linens, flowers, or other decorations are provided. We encourage you to embrace the natural beauty of the space and let the entertainment be the centerpiece. If desired, you are permitted to bring minimalist decor. No decor can be brought to grounds earlier than one hour prior to your event and must be cleaned up no later than one hour after your event. PRF is not responsible for any decor items you bring on site.

MUSIC

Live musical accompaniment will be provided for your wedding ceremony. Musical guests will also be scheduled throughout your reception. No musicians, singers, or recorded music can be brought onto the Faire grounds.

WEDDING CAKE

Cake is provided via Rosie's Creative Cakes (rosiescreativecakes.com). Once your date is booked with PRF, you will receive a link to begin your cake selection process.

CHANGING FACILITIES

There are no designated changing facilities or backstage areas for storage, gifts, flowers, or any additional wedding items. Please plan accordingly.

REHEARSAL

A one-hour Friday rehearsal may be scheduled through Group Sales prior to your wedding. Rehearsals are scheduled to end before 5:00pm. We cannot accommodate same-day rehearsal. All persons involved with rehearsal must be off the grounds by 5:00pm. Vehicles are not allowed on festival grounds.

GUEST TICKETS & REMINDERS

Once your final payment is received, faire admission tickets will be mailed to you. Distribution of tickets to your guests is your responsibility.

Please inform your guests that your wedding ceremony and reception is being held outdoors. The weather is always a factor at an outdoor event. The faire grounds are not suited for high heels. Your wedding guests will appreciate knowing ahead of time that this is a casual affair.
