



PA Ren Faire Weekend Stage Managers

The Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire is seeking applicants to work as stage managers of the upcoming faire season. Located on the grounds of the historic Mt. Hope estate, PARF spans 36 acres, with 7 outdoor stages. The Faire opens the 3rd weekend in August and runs through the last weekend of October.

Stage managers work from 9:00am-7:30pm Saturday and Sundays. Main responsibilities included: Set up and shutdown of physical stages and sound equipment, running sound during performances (We will train you on our system), assisting with change overs of performances, and ensuring the stage/show are run safely and on time. Along with your stage, SMs are also required to help with our finale Joust: jobs include Sound Cues, Light Cues, Backstage Sound Support, Backstage Pyro Safety support (Fire extinguisher). You will also help with Set up and take down of the faire on Saturday morning and Sunday nights ie. Turning off and on Canned music, Hanging up flags, Bringing water to stages, Covering and uncovering Speakers, Crashmats or pools. You may also be asked to cover for other sm's stages from time to time.

Work Hours and Call times: SMs work every Saturday and Sunday from August 17th – Oct 27th 9am-7:30pm Plus a few hours during tech weeks August 3th-16th We will give you this schedule no later than July 14th. Joust tech August 12th is required. You will also be required to attend sound school which will be about 4-5 hours one day right before tech (Typically August 5th or 6th, We will take peoples conflicts at time of hiring into consideration).

Pay: Pay will be \$125 a Faire Day plus \$14 an Hour for work outside of Faire days.

This is a physically demanding job and applicants should be prepared to work outside, rain or shine. Temperatures will range from the upper 90s in July to the mid-30's in October. You will be in costumed. We do make sure you are comfortable and can work in your costume. Applicants should be comfortable working both independently and within a groups.
