

2025 Facebook PHOTO CONTEST

Yuletide at the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire

OFFICIAL RULES

1. Weekly photos contest posts will be announced on the Faire's Facebook page at <https://www.facebook.com/PARENFAIRE/> beginning the week of November 24 through December 8 for a total of three individual contests.
2. Each weekly contest will request submissions of photos taken from the previous Yuletide weekend. The winning photo will be selected based the image's ability to capture and convey the Yuletide spirit.
3. Photo entries must be submitted via the unique link that will be provided in the weekly photo contest post on the Faire's Facebook page at <https://www.facebook.com/PARENFAIRE/> that will allow you to upload your submission (one per person per week) to the PA Ren Faire Dropbox account. Entries must be received by Thursday at noon during the week of each contest.
4. One photo entry per person, per week is permitted. Multiple entries by one individual within a single week's contest will result in disqualification of all entries from that individual for that week's contest.
5. Photos must be taken on the grounds of Yuletide at the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire from the corresponding weekend during the 2025 season to qualify.
6. Black and white or color photographs qualify.
7. Weekly winners will be announced on the Friday of the contest week. Weekly winning photos will be announced on the Faire's Facebook page.
8. All contest photo entries become the property of the Faire. Upon entry, the photographer grants the Faire full rights to publish for any and all purposes, commercial, promotional or otherwise. Individuals entering the Photo Contests agree to allow the Faire to contact them to request the photo be emailed directly to the Faire.
9. Individual commercial use of photographs, movies, tapes, or video recordings of the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire without written consent of the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire is strictly prohibited.
